با نام و یاد خدای متعال جلسه شورای پژوهشی ۱۳۹۶/۵ در تاریخ ۱۳۹۶/۶/۲۶ ساعت ۱۰ برگزار و موارد ذیل بررسی و نتایج به شرح زیر اتخاذ گردید:

۵-۱- موارد تشویقی طرح های برون دانشگاهی به شرح زیر مصوب شد:

الف) امتیاز پژوهشی ویژه (۱۲ تا ۱۵ امتیاز) برای ترفیع سالیانه (غیرقابل ذخیره) و پژوهانه در سال متبقی به اتمام طرح در نظر گرفته خواهد شد.

ب) در صورت قراردادهای با مبالغ کل بالاتر از ۵۰ میلیون تومان مشروط به انجام وظایف آموزشی، آموزشی مجری یک روز کاری به مدت یک ترم کاسته می شود.

ج) چنانچه طرح برون دانشگاهی منجر به مقاله (مقالات) ISI یا ISC گردد، مجری از یک پایه ترفیع تشویقی به هنگام ارائه گزارش طرح در موعد ترفیع سالیانه بهره مند گردد.

د) چنانچه طرح برون دانشگاهی منجر به تولید محصول جدید، بهبود بهره وری فرآیندها یا محصولات پیشین، ارائه سازوکار فناورانه و اثر ارزنده هنری (رضایت کارفرما با ارائه گواهی حسن انجام کار) شود، مجری از یک پایه ترفیع تشویقی (چنانچه پس از ارائه گزارش های چند طرح برون دانشگاهی مجموع ارقام مربوط به مبالغ کل طرح ها از ۱۰۰ میلیون تومان فزونی یابد) به هنگام ارائه گزارش طرح در موعد ترفیع سالیانه بهره مند می گردد.

و) تسهیل انجام امور اداری مربوط به عقد قرارداد توسط دانشگاه و پیگیری در حصول حق الزحمه طرح از سازمان مربوطه منوط به ارائه دقیق و به موقع گزارشات لازم توسط مجری به دفتر ارتباط با صنعت و تصویب اولیه طرح در شورای ارتباط با صنعت دانشگاه می باشد.

۵-۲- مصوب شد در طرح های برون دانشگاهی، ۱۰ درصد مبلغ کل قرارداد بعنوان بالاسری دانشگاه تعلق گیرد. از این مبلغ، ۵ درصد صرف هزینه های دانشگاه، ۲/۵ درصد صرف هزینه های دانشکده و ۲/۵ درصد صرف هزینه های گروه (اولویت در گروه با عضو هیأت علمی مجری طرح) خواهد بود.

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# The Effect of Different Types of Advance Organizers on Reading Comprehension

*Abstract*— The present study was conducted to investigate the effect of different types of advance organizers on English language learners' reading comprehension. A total of 78 university students participated in this study. The researcher randomly assigned the participants to one of the groups according to three advance organizer conditions: pictorial aids, quick facts and vocabulary warm-up. To ensure the equivalence of the three groups in terms of language proficiency, Nelson Language Proficiency Test was administered. The results of the proficiency test indicated that there were no significant differences among the participants in three groups. Participants in each group were asked to read a reading text of roughly 500 words. Immediately after, they were asked to take a reading comprehension test. This procedure was followed for five consecutive sessions and with five different texts. A comparison of the performances of the students in different groups indicated that there was a significant difference between vocabulary warm-up and the other advance organizers (i.e. pictorial aids and quick facts). However, results showed no significant differences between the effects of pictorial aids and quick facts. The implications of the study for developing educational materials are discussed.

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# Teachers' Teaching and Learning Conceptions and their Efficacy of Classroom Management

*Abstract*— Although a great deal of research in education has been devoted to examining effective causes of efficacy among teachers, relatively little of that work has considered the role of teachers' conception of their profession in the enhancement or deterioration of this construct. In view of this, the main purpose of this study was to understand whether and to what extent do L2 teachers' teaching and learning conceptions might be related, and influence, teachers' level of classroom management capability. Eighty-five L2 teachers in different universities and private language institutes in Mashhad and Neyshabur, two cities in the North East of Iran, were selected and were asked to fill out two instruments, namely the Teaching and Learning Conceptions Questionnaire (TLCQ) and the Teacher Sense of Efficacy Scale (TSES). Overall, the results from a Paired Samples T-test showed that teachers were more inclined towards constructivist conceptions of teaching and learning ( $P < 0.05$ ). Moreover, results from a Pearson product-moment correlation revealed that there is a significant positive correlation between teachers' total efficacy level and their constructivist conceptions of learning and teaching. Moreover, significant positive correlations were found between teachers' constructivist conceptions and all three subscales of teacher self-efficacy, Efficacy of Classroom Management, Efficacy of Students' Management, and Efficacy of Instructional Strategies. The results also revealed that there is a significant negative correlation between teachers' total self-efficacy level and their traditional conceptions of learning and teaching. Moreover, significant negative correlations were found between teachers' traditional conceptions and two subscales of teacher self-efficacy. Furthermore, the results from a linear regression consisting of TLCQ factors showed that teachers' constructivist conceptions of teaching and learning could successfully predict higher levels of teachers' sense of self-efficacy. More specifically, teacher self-efficacy explained 19% of the total variance, using teachers' constructivist conceptions of teaching and learning.
